RACE PACK POSTAGE & COLLECTION

When you entered, you will have opted to either have your pack posted or collect your pack so that you have it ahead of race day. If you paid for your race pack to be posted these will be posted out, with the final batch being sent on the 24 February, except for overseas and non-mainland UK addresses (they simply don't arrive in time) and those who opted to collect their race pack. Please note, no packs chosen at entry to be collected will be issued on race day.

Enclosed within your race pack you should find:

- Race Number with Timing Chip attached
- Bag Storage Tag
- Park & Ride Token (if purchased before 30 January)

If you opted for postage and haven't received your race pack please visit the Enquiries marquee on either Friday 7 or Saturday 8 March between times shown for pack pick up collection.



RACE PACK POSTAGE & COLLECTION

Pack collections can **only** be made during the times below.

Please note to collect your pack you must bring photo ID (photocopies or a photo on your phone are acceptable). It is possible to have someone collect your race pack for you if you can no longer make it, but you must email their details (copying them in) from the email address you used to enter, to info@cambridgehalfmarathon.com and they must bring a copy of our reply email and your photo ID with them. Again photos are fine.

In 2025 those who selected to collect your race pack will have two options to choose from. **THERE WILL BE NO RACE PACK COLLECTION ON THE MORNING OF THE RACE**. We will be too busy helping athletes whose packs have gone missing in the post or are from overseas/non-mainland UK.
